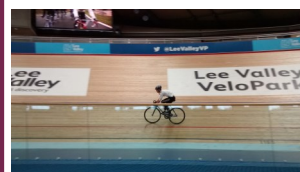
Lee Valley VeloPark;

Our young people were given the opportunity to participate in a four week cycling programme held at the iconic Lee Valley VeloPark. The programme was specifically catered to provide introductory sessions in four cycling disciplines; road racing, BMX, mountain biking and cycling in the award-winning, 6,000 seat velodrome!

The venue supports cycling's continued growth in the UK, with programmes for new people to cycling, schools, clubs and community groups.

Upon completion of the four sessions at the velopark, our young people are now able to access all the tracks at a subsidised cost and enrol on a four stage accreditation course.
